## **Venezuela: March Inflation**

On April 8, Venezuela's Central Bank reported that average consumer price inflation for the month of March was 21%, up from 3.2% in February, and 1.1% in January. The bank attributed the inflationary surge to initial results of economic adjustments. Bank economists predicted that after June, inflation rates would return to normal levels. For 1988, consumer price inflation totaled 35%. (Basic data from Xinhua, 04/08/89)
