## **Mexico: Report On Inflation**

In a report released April 8, the Mexican central bank said that between March 1988 and March 1989 (13 months), consumer price inflation totaled 21.1%, the lowest rate registered in the past nine years. For the month of March, the Banco de Mexico reported a national average rate of 1.1% in March, compared with the month of February. Wholesale prices in March rose an average 1.2%.
