## **Rescheduling Of Cuban Debt To Be Discussed By Club Of Paris**

On April 10, unidentified sources in Paris told AFP that a rescheduling of Cuba's debt will be discussed by the Club of Paris, comprised of creditor governments. Cuban debt to Western nations and lending institutions totals some \$5 billion. Cuba is not a member of the International Monetary Fund, but has maintained contact with the Club of Paris. As a result of severe economic difficulties, in 1986 Havana suspended debt payments. (Basic data from AFP, 04/10/89)
