Brazil & Italy Complete Talks On \$1.5 Billion Cooperation Agreement

On April 18 in Rome, Brazilian and Italian diplomats completed four days of talks on a three-year trade agreement valued at \$1.5 billion. The precise content of the trade agreement was not released. Unidentified officials told AFP that the agreement includes credit, investment and cooperation in the areas of science, technology, transportation, urbanization, and education.
