Mexico To Continue Privatization Program

On April 18, Planning and Budget Secretary Ernesto Zedillo Ponce de Leon said that in 1989 the government will continue its privatization program. He did not mention whether the state-run airline will be privatized this year. The secretary's statement was recorded during a weekly meeting of the evaluation and follow-up committee for the Pacto para la Estabilidad y Crecimiento Economico (PECE). The secretary said that 21 of 200 privatization processes pending at the end of the previous administration had been concluded. (Basic data from Notimex, 04/19/89)
