U.S. Registers Trade Surplus With Mexico During November 1993

A report released by the US Commerce Department on Jan. 19 showed the US registered a US\$188.9 million trade surplus with Mexico during November, after reporting trade deficits in September and October. According to the report, US exports to Mexico totaled US\$3.9 billion during November, an increase of about 18% relative to the US\$3.3 billion in October. In contrast, US imports of Mexican products during November were valued at about US\$3.7 billion, an increase of only about US\$36 million from October. Total US-Mexico trade during January-November 1993 reached US\$74.8 billion, with the trade balance favoring the US by US\$1.5 billion. The value of all trade between the US and Mexico in 1992 was US\$75.8 billion, with the US registering a trade surplus of US\$5.3 billion that year.
