## **Washington Orders Two Nicaraguan Diplomats To Leave U.S.**

On May 31, the US government ordered Nicaraguan diplomats Roberto Vargas and William Vigil to leave the country within 72 hours. State Department spokesperson Richard Boucher said the diplomats had not been guilty of any wrongdoing but were being ordered to leave in retaliation for the "unjustified" expulsion on May 25 of two US diplomats, Joel Cassman and Kathleen Barmon.
