According to report by the Finance and Public Credit Secretariat delivered to the Chamber of Deputies this week, Mexico's public sector deficit in the first quarter of 1989 declined 62% in real terms compared to the same period in 1988. The country's trade surplus for the first quarter totaled \$98.8 million, compared to a trade deficit in the September-December 1988 period. (Basic data from Notimex, 05/16/89)
