Guatemalan President Will Not Attend Inauguration In Argentina

On June 21, presidential spokesperson Claudia Arenas told Notimex that President Vinicio Cerezo will not attend the inauguration of Carlos Menem as Argentine head of state on July 8. As a result of this decision, she said, Cerezo is disposed to participate in a summit with his four Central American counterparts scheduled for July 7-9 in Tegucigalpa. Guatemalan government officials said they had not been contacted regarding the possible postponement of the July summit. The only information they had in this regard, they said, were statements to the press by Costa Rican President Oscar Arias. (Basic data from Notimex, 06/21/89)
