## **Nicaragua: Cease-fire Extended Another Month**

On June 30, the Nicaraguan government announced that it would extend a cease-fire on offensive military operations until July 31 in order to contribute to "the demobilization, relocation or repatriation of the contras." The communique also reported that thus far in 1989, the war with the contras has claimed a total of 1,113 casualties, resulting from "the terrorist policy of the US government."
