In an open letter to President Daniel Ortega published in the July 27 of La Prensa, the National Opposition Union (UNO) said that a five-member UNO committee would meet with the president on July 28 to discuss electoral laws and the use of the media in the campaign. UNO is comprised of 14 opposition parties. At present Nicaragua has 21 legally registered parties, including the Sandinista National Liberation Front (FSLN). (Basic data from AFP, 07/27/89)
