On July 28, Radio Catolica reported that long-time contra leader Adolfo Calero plans to return to Nicaragua to participate in the electoral process. The broadcast did not specify a date for Calero's arrival. Calero left Nicaragua in 1982. He currently resides in Miami. Contra leader Alfredo Cesar returned to Nicaragua on June 11.
