On June 8, Sergio Onofre Jarpa, who served as Interior Minister from 1983 to 1985, announced he had accepted in a June 7 letter the presidential candidacy for the rightist National Renovation Party (RN). Jarpa, 68, is expected to run against Christian Democratic leader Patricio Aylwin, probable candidate for the 17-party opposition coalition, in the Dec. 14 elections.
