According to Argentina's National Grain Council, the 1988-89 combined harvest of corn, sorghum, sunflower, and soybeans is estimated at 11.5 million metric tons, a decline relative to the 1987-88 harvest. Of the four crops, only sunflower production of 3.1 million metric tons registered an increase over the last crop year's 2.8 million tons. (Basic data from Xinhua, 06/17/89)
