In a statement on Aug. 12, Gen. Manuel Antonio Noriega said that the only plebiscite necessary in Panama would consist of a choice between status as a US colony, or defense of dignity as Panamanians. The general spoke at the conclusion of a military exercise called "Zape al Intruso," and in commemoration of his sixth year as commander-in-chief of the Panamanian Defense Forces.
