On Aug. 22, Nicaraguan President Daniel Ortega inaugurated a 75,000 watt radio station in Esteli, 140 km. north of Managua. The new station, he said, will counter the "radio wave invasion" from neighboring Honduras. Voice of Nicaragua will transmit programs to the five northern- most departments where one-third of the nation's 3.2 million citizens reside. According to AFP, the station was built by Soviet technicians. (Basic data from AFP, 08/22/89)
