## **Panama: U.S. Army Officer Dies In Fall From Building**

On Sept. 19, US Lt.Col. Lee Jalesowski died in a fall from the third story of a building at Fort Clayton, 17 km. northeast of Panama City. US Southern Command officials reported the incident on Sept. 20, but gave no details. Pro-government newspaper Critica reported that Jalesowski was a member of a US Army intelligence unit, and that he was thrown to his death. The Southern Command denied the report that the officer was murdered. (Basic data from AFP, 09/21/89)
