On Aug. 15, the Bolivian government received \$5.9 million from Washington, the first installment of a \$23.5 million package earmarked for balance of payments relief. An economic reform program was implemented last week when President Jaime Paz Zamora took office. The US has committed \$90 million in economic and other aid to Bolivia in 1989.
