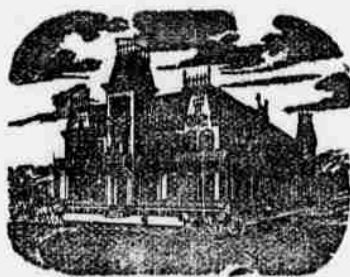

BRIEF WIRINGS:

Sun Strokes.
New York, June 15.—Eighteen cases of heat prostration were reported yesterday by the police. Four of them were fatal.

Called Again.
Providence, June 15.—Hon. Nelson W. Aldrich was re-elected United States senator yesterday. The vote was, Aldrich, 64; David S. Baker, jr., 29.

Harvard Boat Crew Challenged.
Boston, June 15.—Word has been received in this city that the crew of Oxford university, England, has sent an invitation to the Harvard crew to meet them in a contest in English waters sometime this coming fall.

What Protection Does.
Washington, June 15.—During the month of May exports of raw cotton from the United States were \$19,410,394 against \$1,234,023 in May of 1891; of provisions \$10,501,592, against \$7,063,000 in 1891; and of mineral oils, \$5,871,720 against \$3,535,276 in May 1891.

A Congressman Dead.
Washington, June 15.—Gen. Eli T. Stackhouse, member of congress from the 6th district of South Carolina, and a prominent member of the Farmers' Alliance, died in this city yesterday. His remains will be taken to Little Rock, S. C., to-day for interment.

Bradley's Successor.
Washington, June 15.—It was reported here to-day that Judge George A. Massey, of Wilmington, Del., has been tendered the office of justice of the supreme court of the United States, made vacant by the death of Justice Bradley, but it is impossible to verify the report either at the white house or at the department of justice.

In Favor of Bi-Metallic.
SANTA FE, June 15.—At a largely attended meeting held here to-day it was unanimously decided to memorialize parliament to reform the Indian currency by international agreement, establishing bi-metallic standard instead of the establishment of a gold standard. The president of the Calcutta chamber of commerce made an effective speech in which he urged that energetic action be taken to attain the end desired. The movement to secure a reform in the currency is receiving strong support throughout India.

Kansas Politics.
WICHITA, Kas., June 15.—The state convention of the People's party is in session here to-day for the purpose of nominating a congressman at large, a full state ticket, and delegates to the national convention to be held in Omaha in July. The total number of delegates is 560, representing every section of the state. A large number of Democrats are here trying to induce third party people to nominate Attorney General Leven for governor. The rank and file of the People's party are fighting live nomination notwithstanding that in 1890, when he ran for his present office as the nominee of both the People's party and the Democrats, he carried the state by a majority of over 40,000. The Democrats are also asking the third party to support David Overmeyer for congressman at large as the combine candidate against Gov. Anthony.

Wrecked the Wigwam.
CHICAGO, June 15.—This city was visited yesterday afternoon by one of the most severe storms known here in many years. It lasted only a short time, but during that time one person is known to have been killed, many painfully injured and much damage done to property. The great wigwam on the lake front, in which the Democratic national convention is to be held next week, was badly damaged. For three days yesterday hot weather has prevailed in this city. About 3 o'clock this afternoon heavy

clouds began to gather, and half an hour later the darkness was so intense that gas and electric lights had to be called into use in the offices and stores downtown. A few moments after, the tornado swept down upon the city from the northwest, accompanied by terrific thunder and lightning and torrents of rain and hail. In the western division of the city the trees were broken down, awnings torn off and windows shattered. Several buildings in the course of erection were wholly or partially wrecked.

Talking of Adjournment.
WASHINGTON, June 15.—A strong disposition is apparent among members of the house to hasten the hour of final adjournment. All other regular annual appropriations bills have been passed officially by the house except the fortification bill and the general deficiency bill. The last named will be reported to the house within a day or two, and both will receive speedy treatment. Some time is also to be given to the consideration of conference reports, and it is expected that the District of Columbia, the river and harbor, the military academy, and, possibly, the army appropriation bills will be sent to the president for his approval during the week.

This is an extensive programme, but the house managers are extremely anxious to advance the appropriations bills as much as possible before the exodus of the Democratic members toward Chicago begins at the latter end of the week, and they will use every effort to accomplish their purpose.

Illinois Republicans.
CHICAGO, June 15.—The Republican state central committee is in session to-day at the Grand Pacific hotel for the purpose of organizing for the approaching campaign. The meeting, following soon after the nomination of the Republican presidential ticket, is significant to the fact that the fight is to be made on national issues. The Republican and Democratic state tickets are already in the field, the People's party convention meets in a few days, and the Prohibition ticket will be put forward later in the season. All of these organizations owe their origin to national ideas, and the indications now are that the presidential campaign in this state will not be obscured by local issues of any kind. There has been a great deal of furor over the obnoxious compulsory education law, but after the smoke of the first charge has cleared away the German Lutherans will find that both parties are practically pledged to its repeal, and that the question is no longer a party issue. The first work of the committee will be the election of a new chairman to succeed A. M., better known as "Long" Jones, who is no longer a member of the committee.

In Jerry's District.
KINGMAN, Kas., June 15.—The Republicans of the 7th district are in session here to-day for the purpose of nominating a candidate for congress against Jerry Simpson. More than usual importance attaches to the congressional campaign in this district from the fact that Simpson is regarded as the mainstay of the third party in Kansas, and it is thought that his re-election would greatly strengthen that movement and that his defeat would give the Republicans a good prospect of carrying the whole state.

Senator Chester L. Long will in all probability be nominated by to-day's convention, and although but 29 years of age he is regarded as one of the shrewdest politicians in Kansas. He has been pitted against Simpson in several local contests at Medicine Lodge, where both of them have their homes, and has always come out victorious. The Republicans believe he can make a canvass that will beat the scoldish statesman, but the people's party managers claim that when Simpson gets before the people he will stir them up as he did two years ago, and that he will win the fight by 5,000 majority.

Talking of Gorman.
NEW YORK, June 15.—The Herald's Washington correspondent speaking on the outcome of the Chicago convention says that Cleveland will have no walk-over, but the Democratic leaders in Washington believe the ex-president will have to fight hard for his nomination. Continuing the correspondent says:

"Mr. Gorman is the choice, apparently, of his senatorial conferees. Such of his senatorial associates as Cockrell, of Missouri; Vance, of North Carolina; Pugh, of Alabama; George, of Mississippi; Bate, of Tennessee, and Faulkner, of West Virginia, have been working for weeks past in his behalf. Some of them are going to Chicago in his interest, and those who are not will be represented there by politicians who will reflect their wishes. Gorman is known to be popular with the New York politicians, and it is generally thought here that if Hill drops out of the race the New York Democrats are to give him their support."

Of the platform the correspondent says:

"The silver plank to be adopted at Chicago is a subject of considerable discussion among Democratic members of congress. The silver men seem less disposed to make an aggressive fight than the representatives of the mining states at the Republican convention. The opponents of the free coinage are not expecting much difficulty in extending the sort of plank they want, and the friends of free coinage have evidently lost heart by their repeated defeats in the Democratic ranks."

CONGRESSIONAL.
WASHINGTON, June 15.—The silver bill will not be taken up for action until things political shall have got back into their normal condition subsequent to the Democratic national convention, but speeches may be expected upon it and the currency question during almost any

day's session. Mr. Moran is addressing the senate on this subject to-day and endeavor to draw out all the Democratic senators before the national convention meets.

HOUSE.
In the house the truth that was declared on party measures will expire to-morrow, when the Republicans shall have returned from their convention, and there is promise of a busy week, with the tariff again the leading issue.

At this time it is impossible to state the order in which the tariff bills will be taken up, but the probability is the tariff will be the first on the programme if Mr. Shively returns to Washington from Indiana in season, as is expected. The silver bill, and the bill to limit the values of clothing and personal effects that may be brought into the United States by tourists will also receive consideration. As there has already been a free expression of opinion on the general subject of tariff reduction, it is believed that the debate on the first of the measures called up will be broad enough to cover the others.

NEW MEXICO MINES.

Denver, June 15.—Get in at Kingston—no Confidence—made Notes.

David H. Moffat and Sylvester Smith, of Denver, principal owners of the famous silver producers at Creede, have just purchased the gold Tunnel group of claims near Kingston, this territory. James McCullough, of Kingston, is their associate in the deal. The group consists of five claims; \$25,000 was the purchase price, 10 per cent being cash down.

The claims belonged to Wemy Peterson and Frank Raborg, both old-time prospectors and residents of Kingston. The claims are in the Kingston mineral belt and are on Tierra Blanca creek, seven miles south of Kingston and one mile and a half from the Log Cabin mine, a steady silver producer. The largest amount of development on any of the claims of the group is on the Horn Silver claim upon which it is estimated there is 1,000 tons of good free milling gold ore that will pay large profits when machinery is placed on the ground.

The formation of the mountain upon which the claims are located is porphyry and similar in character to that about Deadwood, Dak., and there are evidently large bodies of gold ores in the mountains, and it is found all over it, and a large quartz vein passes through it from which signs have been made to distant points and a profit made to the owners. A good force of men will be put to work upon the properties next week, and two tunnels will be run which will reach the vein much deeper than any of the old workings. The claims are well situated, being only ten miles from Lake Valley, the railway station, from which a natural wagon road runs to the mine. Tierra Blanca camp has always been famous for its rich silver ore in the lime belts, and now, with active development begun on the gold mines in the porphyry belt, the work on the claims for this position of the Kingston district is certainly very flattering. The district is now being actively developed from the Cumberland mine, six miles north, to the Log Cabin, seven miles south.

MINING NOTES.
The Old Abe mine, at White Oaks, is crushing 1,200 tons of ore per month. The crusher for the Albuquerque electric reduction plant has been ordered from San Francisco. The Philadelphia crusher did not meet the requirements.

H. J. Travers, millwright expert from the east, has gone out to put up the Rogers' smelter at La Madera, fifteen miles west of Santa Fe.

Santa Fe continues to decline, and sold at 15c. It seems to be generally conceded that a reorganization of the company and an assessment on the stock is inevitable. —Engineering and Mining Journal.

W. T. Harwood is blasting away at his mine near Coyote canon. It is the opinion of experts in the Sandia formation that when he gets through the iron cap he will strike a body of good ore.—Citizen.

The Denver capitalist has never failed to make money when he invests in New Mexico mines. The recent investments of such men as D. H. Moffat and Sylvester Smith in the Kingston district, will do much to encourage other Colorado men to enter New Mexico for investments.

The Silver Belt Mining company shipped to San Pedro to-day a horse whin and derrick to be used on their property in San Pedro. Their working shaft is now about sixty feet, and well timbered. They are pushing ahead with the development work and the secretary reports the sale of stock increasing.—Albuquerque Citizen.

The last issue of the White Oaks Eagle says: Yesterday the Lady Godiva again became a producer and ore hauling commenced. To-day milling began at the Glass mill. Two shifts are driving a new level night and day to cut the ore body at fifty feet lower, preparatory to stopping. It is hoped that this mine may be able in the future to develop rapidly enough to warrant a new mill before the end of this year.

Mr. W. A. Graves has been elected manager of the St. Louis and Milling company, at Dolores, and will proceed at once to get things in shape for work. He starts men to work to-morrow, and as soon as order can be brought about by straightening up all old matters, the Narod mill will be put to work and doubtless a steady flow of bullion will be the result, such as will warrant the company in making heavy investments.—Cerrillos Rustler.

The most peculiarly attractive gold field in this part of the country are the enormous rich placers and untold leads in the Jicarilla mountains. New leads are constantly being bare, whilst the hard rock of the entire country carries gold, though the bear is of a low grade, whilst all of the free milling rock of the country carries gold in large quantities. The placers are peculiar in that the gold permeates the loose soil and does not entangle upon what is known as "bed rock." The roots of trees and even grass being carefully washed, gold is discovered.—Lincoln Republican.

The accidental discovery of the Lincoln-Lucky mine served to reveal the true form of mineral bodies in lime belts in south Santa Fe county. Tom Wright and his partner, O'Donnell, had a contract for furnishing the San Pedro copper smelter with iron ore for flux. They received \$5 a ton for the ore delivered at the smelter, and were making fair wages. They had a lease of the Lucky mine from which they were extracting the iron. Before they had reached considerable depth in the incline they broke through the bottom of the iron ore and disclosed a body of ore composed of galena and lead carbonates. Iron is the mother of minerals and in connection with lime it is especially significant of good results.

The Army.
Officers at Fort Marcy are much interested in the prospective early appointment by the president of a new brigadier general. Col. Otis, of the 20th infantry, and Col. Carr, of the 6th cavalry, are said to be the chief contestants for the honor of succeeding Gen. David S. Stanley, retired. Both were appointed from New York. Col. Wm. R. Shafter, of the 1st infantry, is the ranking colonel. He is from Michigan, and is also an applicant for the appointment. Col. Otis is said to have the sympathy of an influential New York and Vermont contingent. Of the three Col. Carr is the west's favorite and is especially popular with the people of New Mexico. The last legislative assembly of this territory unanimously adopted a resolution urging the president to promote Col. Carr to be brigadier general.

THE NATIONAL REPUBLICAN TICKET.

GROVER CLEVELAND is listening to what the wild waves are saying and finds that much more pleasant than reading what the New York Sun is saying.

It is a well known fact, that the indictments in the Faustin Ortiz murder case were quashed on demurrers; what's the matter with investigating the case again?

In Santa Fe they shoot to kill.—Chloride Black Range.

What's the matter with you? Don't you know, Santa Fe never does anything by halves.

This is campaign year and the sooner the leaders of the Republican party in this territory acknowledge this fact and act accordingly, the better; get a move on yourselves, gentlemen.

Owing to the Democratic majority in the Santa Fe city council nothing is done that is of benefit to the tax payers and to the city; it's the same old story, wherever and whenever the gang holds sway.

The race for the Republican presidential nomination was not a walk over; the election will not be a walk over; but the successful candidates at Minneapolis will be the victors in the November elections nevertheless.

MR. CLEVELAND has nothing to say on the nomination of President Harrison, but he is, nevertheless, wishing that it had not been made; he knows his goose is cooked, and that should he be nominated, Harrison will beat him in November by a very large majority.

In the statehood bill for New Mexico is defeated in the U. S. senate, the White Cap movement and the White Cap outrages and lawlessness, that have existed in certain counties in New Mexico for the past years, will be responsible. Put this into your pipe and smoke it.

The members of the commission, appointed by Governor Prince to urge the cause of statehood for New Mexico, should meet, organize and act; there is no time to be lost, if New Mexico is to be a state before this year closes.

MR. HENRY VILLARD, of the Northern Pacific railroad, is a strong supporter of Grover Cleveland and is working hard to secure the latter's nomination; it is becoming more and more apparent daily that Cleveland is the gold bug and monopoly candidate for the presidency.

INVESTIGATE THEM.
The grand jury, now in session, should probe the charges and allegations, that the recent unfortunate murders in this county were for political purposes, to the bottom; let the people have all the knowledge that can be gained; if they are political, the good of the community demands that such be shown up; if otherwise, it is certainly but right, proper and just, that such be established.

A GOOD THING.
There is a split in the Democratic party in Alabama; the regular Democracy has nominated a full state ticket headed by Governor Thomas G. Jones; the Alliance Democrats have also nominated, after

withdrawing from the regular Democratic convention, a full ticket headed by R. F. Kell; this is a mighty good thing for Alabama, as well as every other southern state, needs in two well balanced strong parties. Wholesome friction between such aids the cause of good government.

NEED HAVE NO FEAR.

The Globe-Democrat does not favor the admission of New Mexico and Arizona as states; it fears more free silver senators and remarks: "The admission of New Mexico and Arizona would put four more free silver men in the senate. There are too many men of that sort in that body already."

As far as New Mexico is concerned, the Republicans will elect the two senators under the present enabling act if it becomes law and the men elected will stand to and by the silver plank in the Republican national platform.

LET THE SENATE ACT PROMPTLY.

The announcement that the house of representatives has passed the proposed amendments to those paragraphs in the original act establishing the U. S. court of private land claims which deals with the small holdings of land, is a very gratifying piece of news for New Mexico. The bundling features of these sections Nos. 16, 17 and 18 as regards actual residence upon, proofs of residence, description of property, etc., and the short limit of two years in which authority to present claims under these provisions, was allowed, were long ago, in fact, from the very passage of the original act itself, recognized as positive defects in the law which would render it practically inoperative. It was, however, the best that could be had at the time since congress, despite its forty years of "piddling" with the land grant subject, had yet a very imperfect idea of the real status of affairs; and it was accepted by those most interested as a matter that would right itself in time.

Last year Surveyor General Hobart took up the subject and vigorously pressed it before the land department, and as a result a bill was prepared embodying the amendments which the surveyor general deemed necessary. This bill was presented to congress in January last, accompanied by a strong letter of endorsement from the commissioner of the general land office and within a few days past has come the news of the favorable action in the lower house thereon.

The full purport of these several amendments have already been published in the New Mexican. That they are important may be seen at a glance. They practically cover the very essence of the act so far as the greater number of land claimants in New Mexico is concerned, and should the bill containing these amendments become law it would go a very long way toward a prompt and equitable adjustment of land titles in this territory. We sincerely hope that the senate will take up and pass the bill at an early date.

PRESS COMMENTS.

Cleveland's New Book.

Colorado and the Territories.

The people of Colorado favor the admission of New Mexico and Arizona as states into the Union, not solely from sentimental considerations or on the ground of abstract justice. They have business reasons for so doing. The construction of the proposed railroad from Trinidad straight south to El Paso will put Colorado in direct communication over an independent railroad line with the two territories.

Denver will have an almost air line south to the flourishing city on the Rio Grande just where it commences to make the boundary between this republic and Mexico. That line will traverse a country of great and varied resources, the trade of which will naturally come to Denver, the nearest great commercial center. As we of this fair commonwealth well know, the advantages and the opportunities of statehood will include a spirit of hope and expectation and ambition, that will operate as a powerful stimulant to accelerate the development of that great and rich section, and to cause the rapid building up of towns and cities.

Statehood creates the idea of fixedness and permanence of establishment. It inspires confidence. Thus enterprise is stronger and more active in states than in territories. Great undertakings are entered upon more readily, with greater assurance and with larger expectations.

As New Mexico and Arizona, endowed with the advantages of states, shall engage the more vigorously and confidently in the development of their marvelous resources, and shall grow the more rapidly in population and wealth, Denver's opportunities of trade will be correspondingly enlarged and her possibilities of profit proportionately increased. And the benefits which the capital city shall reap will necessarily be shared by the other cities and towns of the state.

Therefore our senators in congress will be working for the benefit of their immediate constituents in striving to secure the passage of the bills admitting the territories to the south and southwest of us. They, perhaps, come the nearest being the representatives of these territories in the senate of any members of that body. They can speak for them with peculiar fitness, and have the knowledge to enable them to speak with force and effect.—Denver Sun.
