The parents are seeking compensation for the boy's medical expenses, pain and suffering, and other damages. The Santa Fe railroad is denying any fault in the accident. Other suits have been filed against the railroad in recent months for similar accidents.

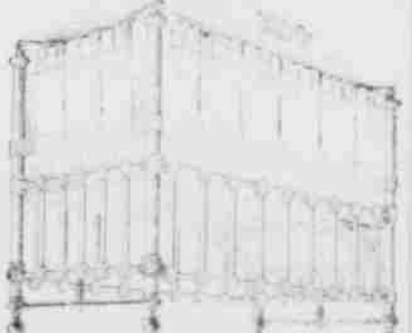
