## **Salvadoran Rebels Ambush Military Convoys**

On Nov. 5, a report by the Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN) broadcast over Radio Venceremos said that rebels ambushed two military convoys on Nov. 4, wounding 26 soldiers. In the first attack near the eastern town of Apastepeque, the rebels caused 17 casualties among the soldiers and destroyed an armored car with a mine. A second ambush took place on the Panamerican highway, where nine soldiers were wounded. The radio broadcast also said that in San Salvador, rebels attacked a police car, injuring two policemen inside. (Basic data from AFP, 11/05/89)
