This week, Guatemala's immigration service announced that beginning Feb. 1, all Central Americans, excepting Costa Ricans, will be required to acquire visas before entering Guatemala. Guatemala had been the only nation in the region that did not require visas from citizens of other Central American countries. The immigration service has also suspended border passes.
