Brazil: 2.2% Gdp Growth Predicted For 1989

On Nov. 8, the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics (IBGE) predicted a GDP growth rate for the year of 2.2%. National accounts department chief Claudio Considera said the estimate was based on growth registered from January through September. Assuming a 2.2% growth rate, Brazil's GDP will total \$360 billion, compared to \$352 billion in 1988. (Basic data from O Estado de Sao Paulo, 11/08/89)
