Brazil: U.S. Market Steel Quota Increased

On Nov. 8, a fourth round of negotiations was concluded on the Brazilian share of Washington's steel import quotas. Under a preliminary agreement, Brazil will be able to export 1.55 million tons of steel per annum to the US, or a 1.8% market quota. The previous quota of 1.3% was equal to 1.2 million tons.
