## **Izvestia Says Nicaragua Owes U.S.s.r. 910 Million Rubles**

In its Feb. 28 issue, Soviet newspaper Izvestia published a list of 49 countries owing a total debt to Moscow equivalent to about \$137 billion. Heading the list was Cuba, with a debt of 15.49 billion rubles (US\$24 billion). Fourteenth was Nicaragua at 910 million rubles. (Basic data from AFP, 03/01/90)
