Nicaragua: Notes On Municipal Elections (s/s)

As of March 1, unofficial results from Region I Supreme Electoral Council vote count showed that in the municipal elections for Esteli, the FSLN received 57.9% of the vote; UNO, 37.6%; PRT, 0.9%. Registered voters in the municipality numbered 39,857. Total ballots cast: 36,621. Null/invalid ballots: 1,637. Municipalities in Region I where the FSLN has a majority on respective municipal councils include Jalapa, Dipilto, Ocotal, San Fernando, Cusmapa, Condega, Pueblo Nuevo, Esteli. For Region III, which includes Managua, selected municipal returns follow: Municipality UNO FSLN # of seats on municipal council Managua 16 4 Tipitapa 9 1 Villa Carlos 3 2 Fonseca Mateare 2 3 San Francisco 2 3 Libre San Rafael 9 1 del Sur [Basic data from 03/01/90 report, Central America Resource Center (Minneapolis, Minn.); 03/02/90 report, Nicaragua Network (Washington, DC); 03/03/90 report, Hemisphere Initiative (Washington, DC)]
