## **Inter-american Development Bank Loans For Chile, Bolivia, Uruguay**

On Nov. 29, the Inter-American Development Bank announced approval of a \$360 million loan to Chile earmarked for medium- and long-term lending to private sector enterprises. Next, the IDB announced approval of a \$34.6 million loan for Bolivia destined to finance small-scale projects with high labor content. An objective of this loan is to mitigate the social costs of Bolivia's ongoing economic crisis. The IDB also announced disbursement of \$26.2 million to Uruguay for the second phase of a drainage and sewer system program for the capital city, Montevideo. (Basic data from Notimex, 11/29/89)
