In an interview to be published March 11 in the Bildam Sonntag newspaper, Economic Cooperation Minister Juergen Warnke said his government plans to resume development aid to Nicaragua, and that he plans to visit Managua after Violeta Barrios de Chamorro is installed as president on April 25. Warnke said that Bonn planned to send immediate food and health assistance. The government was also prepared to "possibly take over reasonable East German projects in Nicaragua."
