## **Honduras: Bomb Explodes In Downtown Tegucigalpa**

On March 15 in downtown Tegucigalpa, a bomb exploded injuring two persons. Pamphlets strewn about in the locale signed by the "Estado Mayor del Ejercito de Resistencia Patriotica 1827," said that the new government of President Rafael Leonardo Callejas had demonstrated within a few days of assuming power its "pro-imperialist and oligarchical essence." The organization stated that the government's economic austerity package approved last week was dictated by the International Monetary Fund. Included are price hikes for medicines and gasoline, and increased income and sales taxes. (Basic data from Notimex, 03/15/90)
