In a financial report released Dec. 7 by UN Secretary General Javier Perez de Cuellar, the UN will close out the year with a \$315 million short-term deficit. Regular budget arrears during the 1978-1988 period totaled \$1.508 billion. As of Oct. 31, the US owed the UN \$435 million in contributions to the regular budget, and \$190 million for peacekeeping operations. (Basic data from Xinhua, 12/07/89)
