According to a study by the General Accounting Office, conducted at the request of Sen. Edward Kennedy, \$685 million in US aid to El Salvador is still "in the pipeline." Included are \$139 million in military aid, \$135 million in economic assistance, and \$412 million in humanitarian and development aid. The report concludes that \$45 million of the military aid, and all of the economic aid is "not committed" and could be reduced or cut off without legal problems.
