## **Mexico: Estimate Of 1989 Inflation**

According to report released Dec. 14 by the Center of Private Sector Economic Studies (CEESP), Mexico will close out the year with an annual consumer price level inflation rate of 26.4%. CEESP predicts a 21% devaluation of the peso in 1990, equivalent to a 1.6% devaluation per month. (Basic data from Notimex, 12/14/89)
