## **El Salvador: Notes On Recent Fighting**

April 5: Urban commandos pertaining to the Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN) attacked with artillery fire several military facilities located on the southern perimeter of San Salvador. In the northern part of the capital city, rebels attacked a National Guard post. April 7: At least three electricity pylons were destroyed by dynamite explosions Saturday night in the Escalon and Miramonte neighborhoods of San Salvador, causing prolonged blackouts. Government sources reported that in the past week economic sabotage and attacks on military targets by rebels caused nearly 30 rebel and troop casualties.
