On April 11 in Managua, Roberto Ferrey, who headed president-elect Violeta Barrios de Chamorro's delegation in the weekend talks with contra leaders (see CAU 04/11/90), told reporters in Managua that only 1,000 contras remain in the Yamales, Honduras, camps. Demobilization of the contras in the Honduran camps is to begin April 18. The rest, he said, are in Nicaragua. (Basic data from Notimex, 04/11/90)
