Nicaragua: President Annuls Agrarian Reform, Orders Review Of Confiscations & Laws Approved In Feb. 25-april 25 Period

On May 11, President Violeta Barrios de Chamorro annulled the agrarian reform implemented by the previous Sandinista National Liberation Front (FSLN) government, and announced a review of confiscations carried out since 1979. She also told reporters that she had ordered a review of all laws and decrees approved by the government between Feb. 25 and April 25. Chamorro said seized lands would be distributed to "guarantee justice for all, without party distinctions, and at the same time preserve the rights of those farmers who benefitted from agrarian reform."
