Guatemala: Four Soldiers Killed In El Peten Department

On May 5, Guatemalan military sources reported that an officer and three soldiers died when their vehicle hit a claymore mine near the village of Naranjo, El Peten department. The sources said the incident occurred when the soldiers had been returning to base after a routine patrol, and that the mine had likely been placed by members of the Guatemalan National Revolutionary Unity (URNG).
