On June 4, police reported that five corpses had been discovered in the past 24 hours near Guatemala City in the villages of Villa Canales, Amatitlan, Palin and Mixco. Police said all victims had been beaten and shot to death, and some of them had been tortured. Daily newspaper Siglo XXI said in its June 4 edition that the five victims had been abducted in recent days by unidentified armed men. The victims could not be identified.
