On June 5, Chamber of Commerce president Ricardo Aleman told reporters that Panamanian businesspersons wish to continue trade links with Cuba, despite plans by President Guillermo Endara's government to suspend diplomatic relations with Havana. Aleman said that while Panama has no formal economic relations with Cuba, certain companies in Panama's free trade zone "take advantage of the socialist country's market."
