## **Nicaraguan President Claims Arms Shipments To El Salvador Continue**

According to a senior State Department official cited by the New York Times (06/20/90), President Violeta Barrios de Chamorro told Secretary of State James Baker that arms shipments to the Salvadoran rebels continue to pass through Nicaragua. The conversation reportedly took place June 18 at the close of a three-day meeting of Central American presidents in Antigua, Guatemala. The official, who requested anonymity, said the Nicaraguan president also indicated that radio messages were still being transmitted from Nicaragua to the Salvadoran guerrillas.
