Central American Nations To Request \$161 Million In Aid For Refugees & Displaced

According to a report by the New York Times (06/26/90), Central American diplomats will request \$161 million from advanced capitalist nations June 27 at the United Nations to serve nearly half a million people made homeless by civil wars. The request will be presented at the second session of a 60-nation conference called to discuss ways of assisting the region's refugees and displaced persons. Estimates of war refugees and displaced cited by the Times include: 900,000 displaced within their own countries; about 250,000 refugees who fled their homes to neighboring Central American nations; and, between 800,000 and 900,000 currently residing in Mexico, the US and elsewhere outside the region.
