El Salvador: Military Academy Instructor Assassinated

On July 17, the armed forces press agency reported that Capt. Aristides Ramon Reyes Hernandez was shot several times by two men riding a motorcycle in Santa Tecla, about 10 km. from San Salvador. Reyes was attacked as he and his wife were driving in their car. Cecilia Margarita Sandoval was wounded. There was no immediate claim of responsibility for Capt. Reyes' killing. The captain worked as an instructor at the military academy in San Salvador. (Basic data from AFP, Notimex, 07/17/90)
