## **Honduran Army Accused Of Killing Salvadoran Agricultural Worker**

In a July 18 broadcast over Radio Venceremos, the Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN) denounced the Honduran government and army for the assassination of a Salvadoran agricultural worker, Julio Perez Gomez. Perez, said the FMLN, was killed by Honduran soldiers in Salvadoran territory. According to the FMLN, the incident occurred in El Zancudo, Morazan department, two kilometers from the Salvadoran-Honduran border. This location is part of "territorial pockets" currently in dispute between the two countries before the World Court at The Hague. Notimex mentioned that Perez's death has not been confirmed by either government. (Basic data from Notimex, 07/18/90)
