On July 18, Lt.Col. Carlos Camilo Hernandez told reporters that he had not ordered the burning of military academy log books considered crucial evidence in the Nov. 16 murders of six Jesuit educators, their housekeeper and her daughter. He spoke with reporters after asking a judge to postpone his hearing until a new defense lawyer is named.
