Panama Receives \$107.9 Million Installment Of U.S. Emergency Aid Package

On July 24, the US authorized payment of \$107.9 million earmarked for recovery of the private sector. The funds are part of a \$420 million supplemental emergency aid package approved by Congress in May. Thus far, Washington has disbursed \$351.7 million of the package. The remaining \$68.5 million are earmarked for financing of long-term priority projects, such as human resource development, investment and export promotion, national resource administration, and investment in environmental programs focused around the Canal.
