Guatemala: Congressperson Assassinated

On July 25, National Center Union (UCN) Deputy Rolando Ruano Reyes and UCN member Roberto de Jesus Espinoza were shot to death by unidentified persons near San Jose Acatempa, Jutiapa department. Party spokespersons said the motive for the killings was unknown. Ruano Reyes is the third congressperson to be assassinated since President Vinicio Cerezo took power in 1986. Christian Democrat Deputies Leonel Rodriguez and Victor Moscoso Machorro were killed in similar circumstances. (Basic data from Notimex, 07/25/90, 07/26/90)
