## **Guatemala: Encounter Between Rebel & Private Business Leaders Scheduled For Aug. 20 In Canada**

On Aug. 9, Guatemala's National Reconciliation Commission announced that a meeting between leaders of the Guatemalan National Revolutionary Unity (URNG) and the nation's private business sector would take place Aug. 20 in Vancouver, Canada. Retired colonel Francisco Gordillo, representative of opposition political parties on the Commission, said the talks are part of the calendar established by the Commission and the URNG last March in Oslo (Norway), and commenced via the political program advanced in late May in El Escorial (Spain). Subsequent to the Aug. 20 encounter, the URNG has agreed to participate in talks with trade union leaders, the Catholic Church, and government and military delegations.
