Brazil: 1989 Trade Surplus, \$16.1 Billion

On Jan. 17, according to a report released by the Banco do Brasil's trade division (Carteira de Comercio Exterior-CACEX) the trade surplus in 1989 totaled \$16.1 billion, compared to a \$19 billion in 1988. 1988 exports and imports: \$33.789 billion, \$14.6 billion. 1989 exports and imports: \$34.392 billion, \$18.281 billion. For the month of December 1989, imports totaled \$1.893 billion, and exports, \$2.763 billion. CACEX predicts a \$10 billion trade surplus for 1990. (Basic data from Folha de Sao Paulo, 01/18/90)
