El Salvador: Judge Issues Arrest Order In Jesuit Murder Case

On Aug. 24, Judge Ricardo Zamora issued an order for the arrest of Sgt. Oscar Solorzano, defendant in the November 1989 murders of six Jesuit priests and two women. National Guard troops reported that Solorzano had fled San Salvador. Solorzano was a commander of the Atlacatl battalion command at the time of the murders, and participated in a search and seizure operation of the clergypersons' home three days before the killings.
