On Aug. 14, daily newspaper El Grafico (Guatemala) reported that the Mutual Support Group for Families of the Disappeared (GAM) delivered a formal demand to the Interior Minister and National Police chief to identify persons responsible for continued threats against leaders of the Coordinator of Secondary School Students (ANEEM).
