In a speech to the Mexico City Rotary Club on Feb. 16, US Ambassador John D. Negroponte said bilateral trade in 1989 totaled \$52 billion, a 20% increase over 1988, and 50% more than in 1987. Trade between the two countries, he said, must be liberalized in order to continue analyzing prospects for establishing a US-Canada-Mexico common market by 1992. (Basic data from Notimex, 02/16/90)
